This responds to your letter of December 23, 1985, to this Office inquiring as to the best way to be apprised of changes in NCUA regulations and policies.

As you know, all changes or proposed changes to the NCUA Rules and Regulations are published in the Federal Register. Accordingly, we would suggest using the Federal Register as a primary source. You might also want to check with our Public Information Office to see if there have been any press releases or letters to credit unions involving policy changes. Lastly, up-to-date information can be obtained by subscribing to the various newsletters concerning credit union matters. We should also point out that a loose leaf service is published by Matthew Bender on credit union law.
