Dear Ms. Novinski:

This responds to your letter dated March 27, 1986, concerning the offering of a sweepstakes promotion in conjunction with the sale of traveler's checks at Federal credit unions (FCU's).

The proposed sweepstakes promotion consists of two parts: a consumer promotion and a teller promotion. No purchase or transaction is required to participate in either promotion. Entry blanks may be obtained by written request.

Participation in a sweepstakes program is authorized as incidental to an FCU's power to sell traveler's checks. Accordingly, FCU participation is within the discretion of an FCU's board of directors. We recommend, however, that you consider other state or Federal laws that may be applicable to such promotions. As you recognize, to the extent that the program would violate state laws, i.e. lottery laws, etc., FCU participation would not be permitted.

I hope we have been of assistance.
