Dear Mr. Fram:

You have requested our opinion concerning suspension of services to Federal credit union ("FCU") members who have caused a loss to an FCU. Enclosed please find several letters on this issue. In general, an FCU member has two fundamental rights which cannot be taken away or limited without a formal expulsion under Section 118 of the FCU Act (12 U.S.C. §1764). Those rights are: (1) to vote in all elections, and (2) to hold a share account in the FCU.
