## Re: Bankruptcy Policy (Your February 10, 1992, Letter)

Dear Ms. Lemons:

You have asked whether your credit union can deny services to a member who has filed for bankruptcy and caused a loss to the credit union. We do not have any jurisdiction over this issue since it concerns a state-chartered credit union. We offer no opinion as to whether the policy under discussion violates any state or federal law, including the Federal Bankruptcy Act. You should determine which laws are relevant and whether the course you propose is allowed under those laws. Your state regulator and the Virginia Credit Union League may be able to provide assistance in this regard.
